v. August 1 out-of-season rule will automatically be waived in specific situations

vi. ML schools may opt to schedule non-registered officials except in FB and WR

vii. Requires a running clock if a 40 point differential is reached in basketball

viii. ML basketball players may play two ML games a day, eight times in a season. 8 quarters per day, but limited to 40 quarters per season.

ix. 5 Baker Games is the same as 1 regular game (bowling)

x. Freshman who play 3 quarters or less may play in a fifth quarter

xi. Adds Boys and Girls Lacrosse to WIAA sanctioned sports
