Tennis: Regional format was in question...(Top four B girls and top 3 boys will compete against the top 4/3 "A" players to seed the top 4 girls and top 3 boys to state.)

Golf: A scheduling conflict was presented on Sub-District date of May 11th. There is an AP test that day and Odessa-Harrington will have a participant presenting at a National History conference in California. A solution was presented and approved that any student with an educational conflict on May 11th will be able to play their sub-district round on the scheduled date of Monday April 25th when there is a league meet at Deer Park. Those players will have a marker and play by the same sub-district rules. Their score will qualify them for the district date but they will not be eligible for sub-district medal or team points. This will only work for sub-district play, not district.
