18.19.2 PARTICIPATION WITH THE HIGH SCHOOL TEAM - A 1B or 2B high school may use eighth grade students from a WIAA member feeder middle school/junior high to salvage viable varsity or junior varsity high school teams or if no middle level program is offered in that sport during the same season. Eighth grade students may not be used to salvage individual sports programs (bowling, cross country, golf, gymnastics, swimming, tennis, track and field, or wrestling.

)

- A. The school must have a history of offering the sport at that level, and is not beginning a program at any level.

- B. Eighth graders could be used to salvage the high school varsity team if at any time during the season the number of participants on the high school team does not exceed specified numbers. That specified number of participants is the nearest whole number equal to 175 percent (%) of the number of participants required to start a contest.

- C. Eighth graders could be used to salvage the high school junior varsity team if at any time during the season the number of participants on the high school team does not exceed specified numbers. That specified number of participants is the number of participants required to start a contest plus the nearest whole number equal to 175 percent (%) of the number of participants required to start a contest.

- D. Any and all eligible eighth graders interested in playing at the high school level could practice with the high school junior varsity or varsity teams, but the combined roster for both the junior varsity and the varsity contests would be limited to the specified numbers in 18.19.2.C on any given day.
- E. Any eighth graders moved up to salvage a junior varsity team are eligible to play only on the junior varsity team.
