New Business: What will be the structure of the league with Republic coming down next year? Wellpinit will go south for every sport, except football due to geography of the league. Columbia will move to the south for volleyball to make it 6/6 north/south. They will stay north for basketball to make it 7/6. (St. Michaels is the difference without volleyball.)

Football, Darin Reppe: Entiat, Pateros, Waterville will be joining our league, they would be in the south league. Darin will continue working on the schedule for a complete schedule including cross-over non-league.

Volleyball, Erik Stark: Preseason/Postseason meeting discussion. Erik will try to schedule NWC again next year for championships. Coaches would like to have a post season meeting to discuss all opponents. It is up to the coaches if they want to continue a three win night into a five match night to play some JV games, if they didn't already have a JV game that night. Some associations charge for the extra two and it may not be cost effective. Schools need to make sure that WIAA recognizes that they have a JV squad. Erik will look at tournament scheduling with Wellpinit and Columbia coming to south.

Basketball, Bryan Myers: 2/7 boys home sites, 2/8 girls home sites. Deer Park will host on February 11, 15 & 18. Deer Park would like to exclude bands on championship nights due to limited seating, AGREED.

Pig-tail game is needed for the boys and girls with Panorama 5 playing at South 4 on Saturday 2/4/2012. Winner is South #4. If the school from the north has both girls and boys involved a possibly hosted at best site available.
